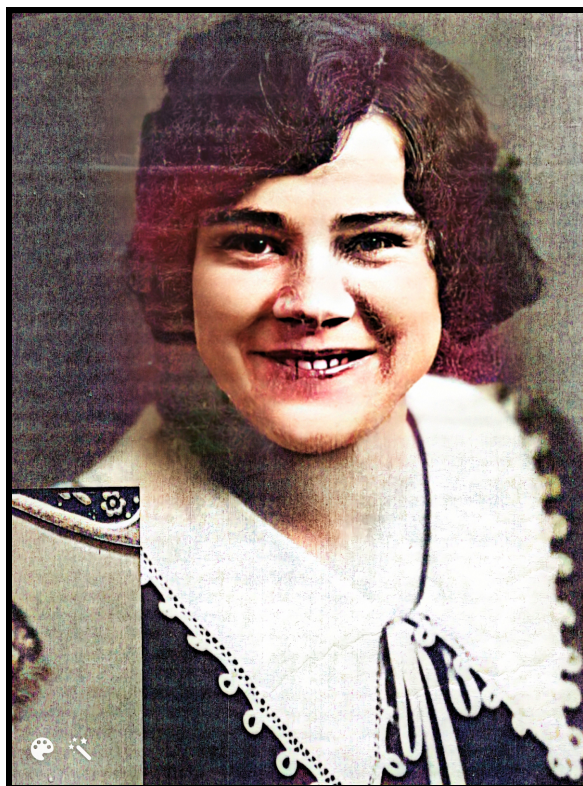
## G. Caauwe rites planned for Tuesday

Services for Mrs Frank (Grace) Caauwe, 75, 1202 Terrace Rd Norfolk, will be Tuesday at 11 a m at the First United Presbyterian Church. The Rev B C Poncelow will officiate, and burial will be in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery.

Visitation will be 3 to 9 p m Monday at the Home for Funerals.

Mrs Caauwe died Oct 27 at a local nursing home. She was born July 3, 1908, in Pierce County to the late William and Lizzie Wenke. On July 19, 1930, at Norfolk she married Frank Caauwe. They owned and operated a service station on North First Street in Norfolk for 25 years and then owned and operated the Caauwe Gun Shop until retiring about 7½ years ago. Mrs Caauwe and her husband were among founders of the 49'ers Square Dance Club in 1949. Mrs Caauwe was also a past noble grand of the Rebekah Lodge.

Surviving are her husband, two sons, Russell of Fremont and Tom of Norfolk, eight grandchildren, three great-grandchildren and one sister, Mrs Opal Kennedy of Grand Island. She was preceded in death by two brothers.
