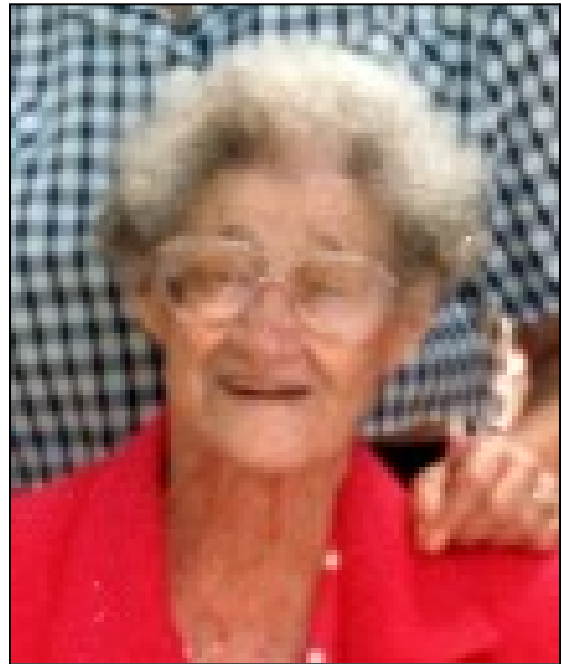
Esther and her beloved husband of 54 years resided in Meadow Grove, Neb., for 50 years, and relocated to Las Vegas in their later years.

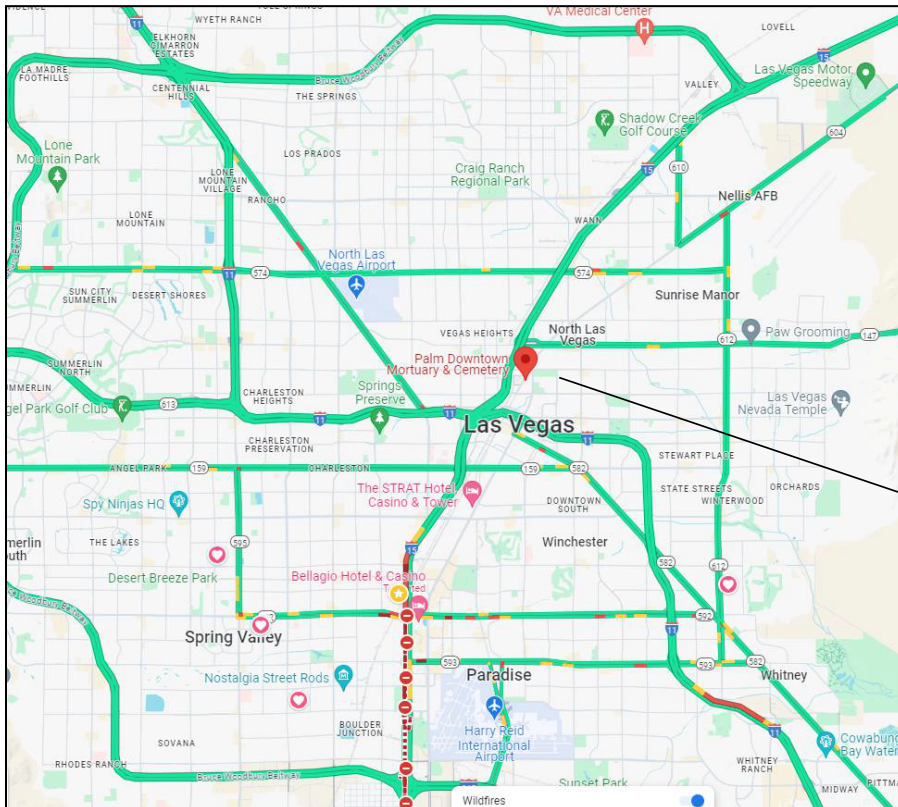
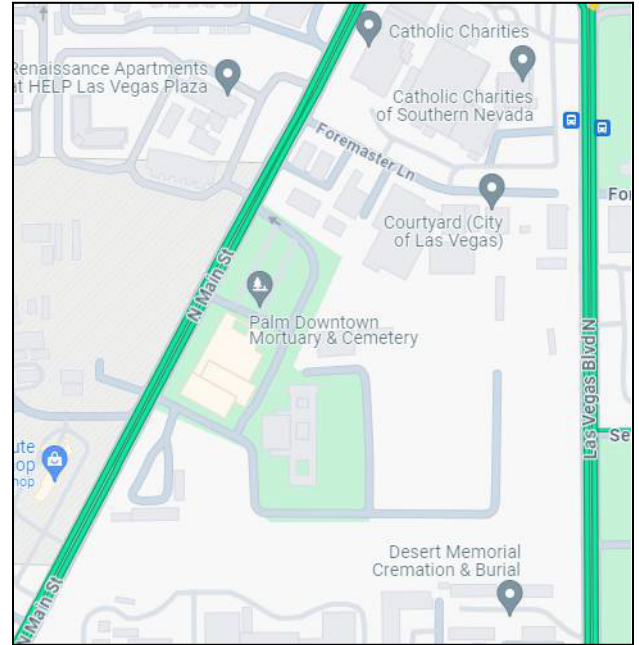
